

**AMENDMENT TO H. CON. RES. 312. AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. TIM MURPHY OF
PENNSYLVANIA AND MR. HELLER OF NEVADA**

Reduce the amounts on page 3, line 10, and page 4, lines 1 through 5, by the following amounts: fiscal year 2008: \$0, fiscal year 2009: \$0, fiscal year 2010: \$0, fiscal year 2011: \$7,071,000,000, fiscal year 2012: \$35,389,000,000, and fiscal year 2013: \$35,601,000,000.

Amend page 4, lines 9 through 14, to read as follows: fiscal year 2008: \$0, fiscal year 2009: \$0, fiscal year 2010: \$0, fiscal year 2011: \$7,071,000,000, fiscal year 2012: \$35,389,000,000, and fiscal year 2013: \$35,601,000,000.

Increase the amounts on page 5, lines 16 through 18 by the following amounts: fiscal year 2011: \$7,071,000,000, fiscal year 2012: \$35,389,000,000, and fiscal year 2013: \$35,601,000,000.

At the end of title II, add the following:

- 1 **SEC. ____ 2. RECONCILIATION FOR ECONOMIC GROWTH AND**
2 **TAX FAIRNESS.**
3 (a) **IN THE HOUSE.**—The House Committee on Ways
4 and Means shall report a reconciliation bill not later than

1 June 8, 2008, that consists of changes in laws within its
2 jurisdiction sufficient to reduce revenues by not more than
3 \$40,900,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2009
4 through 2013, and to decrease outlays by not less than
5 \$78,061,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2009
6 through 2013.

7 (b) PURPOSE.—The reconciliation legislation re-
8 ported pursuant to subsection (a) shall make the changes
9 in the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 such that the
10 amount of the child tax credit provided to American tax-
11 payers shall not be reduced during the fiscal years covered
12 by this resolution.
