

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3021, AS REPORTED

OFFERED BY MR. Shadegg of Arizona

Page 5, line 18, strike “308(a)” and insert “307(a)”.

Page 6, line 3, strike “308(a)” and insert “307(a)”.

Page 10, line 14, strike “308(b)” and insert “307(b)”.

Page 7, strike lines 3 through 17 and insert the following:

1 (3) GRANTS TO LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGEN-
2 CIES.—

3 (A) APPLICATION.—A State shall require a
4 local educational agency to submit an applica-
5 tion for a project for which the agency seeks
6 funding under this Act in such time and man-
7 ner as may be required by the State.

8 (B) PRIORITY.—A State shall give priority
9 to applications submitted under subparagraph
10 (A) that demonstrate how the project will re-
11 duce the local education agency’s consumption
12 of energy. Each State shall determine what
13 projects meet this criterion, except that a State

1 shall ensure that a local educational agency
2 does not receive funds under this priority unless
3 it demonstrates that the project will reduce the
4 consumption of energy by at least 5 percent.
5 After reviewing the applications and applying
6 the State's criterion, the State shall rank all
7 such applications in descending order from
8 those showing the greatest reduction in energy
9 consumption to those showing the least reduc-
10 tion in energy consumption. From the amount
11 allocated to a State under paragraph (1) and
12 not reserved under paragraph (2), a State shall
13 award funds based on the ranking, with pref-
14 erence to local educational agencies whose ap-
15 plications demonstrate the greatest reduction in
16 energy consumption in descending order until
17 such funds are exhausted.

18 (C) REMAINING FUNDS.—If, after applying
19 subsection (a)(2), a State has remaining funds,
20 such funds shall be allocated to each local edu-
21 cational agency in the State that meets the re-
22 quirements of section 1112(a) of the Elemen-
23 tary and Secondary Education Act of 1965
24 shall receive an amount in proportion to the
25 amount received by such local educational agen-

1 cy under part A of title I of that Act for the
2 previous fiscal year relative to the total amount
3 received by all local educational agencies in the
4 State under such part for such fiscal year.

Beginning on page 13, strike line 8 through page 14, line 15 (and redesignate provisions and amend the table of contents accordingly).

Page 15, line 10, after the semicolon, insert “and”.

Page 15, strike lines 11 through 18 (and redesignate provisions accordingly).
