OFFERED BY MR. JINDAL OF LOUISIANA**

Page 14, line 20, insert “(a) IN GENERAL.—” before “Section 7”.

Page 15, after line 6, insert the following:

1 (b) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION VICTIMS OF HURRI-
2 CANES KATRINA, RITA, AND WILMA.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 7(f)(1) of the Small
4 Business Act (as added by subsection (a)) applies
5 retroactively to any loan under section 7(b) of that
6 Act that was made—

7 (A) in response to Hurricane Katrina,
8 Hurricane Rita, or Hurricane Wilma of 2005;
9 and

10 (B) for a small business located in a coun-
11 ty or parish designated by the Administrator of
12 the Small Business Administration as a disaster
13 area by reason of such Hurricane Katrina,
14 Hurricane Rita, or Hurricane Wilma, as appli-
15 cable.

16 (2) DISCLOSURE OF ACCRUED INTEREST.—
17 Whenever the Administrator provides an option to

1 defer repayment under paragraph (1), the Adminis-
2 trator shall disclose the accrued interest that must
3 be paid under the option.
