**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4137, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. INSLEE OF WASHINGTON**

Page 365, after line 11, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 466. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING PERKINS**
2 **LOANS.**

3 It is the sense of Congress that—

4 (1) the Federal Perkins Loan Program, which
5 provides low-interest loans to help needy students fi-
6 nance the costs of postsecondary education, is an
7 important part of Federal student aid, and should
8 remain a campus-based aid program at colleges and
9 universities; and

10 (2) in order to strengthen the Federal Perkins
11 Loan Program, the Federal Government should sup-
12 port increased funds to the Program and restore the
13 capital contribution funds for the Program, to pro-
14 vide more low-income students with affordable bor-
15 rowing options.

Page 512, strike lines 4 through 7 and insert the
following:

16 “(e) PROHIBITION.—No funds made available under
17 this part may be used to provide financial assistance—

1 “(1) to students who do not meet the require-
2 ments of section 484(a)(5); or

3 “(2) to any institution of higher education after
4 the date of enactment of this subsection unless the
5 institution demonstrates to the Secretary that the
6 institution meets or exceeds the most current version
7 of ASHRAE/IES Standard 90.1 (as such term is
8 used in section 342(a)(6) of the Energy Policy and
9 Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6313(a)(6)) for any
10 new facilities construction or major renovation of
11 that institution after that date, except that this
12 paragraph shall not apply with respect to barns or
13 greenhouses or similar structures owned by the insti-
14 tution.”.

Page 658, line 22, after “energy management,” in-
sert “greenhouse gas emissions reductions,”.

Page 661, line 15, after “energy management,” in-
sert “greenhouse gas emissions reductions,”.
