Loan forgiveness

Page 335, after line 14, insert the following new paragraph:

1 “(14) PHYSICAL THERAPISTS.—Individuals who
2 are physical therapists and who are providing phys-
3 ical therapy services to children, adolescents, or vet-
4 erans.

Page 338, after line 21, insert the following new paragraph (and redesignate the succeeding paragraphs accordingly):

5 “(5) PHYSICAL THERAPIST.—The term ‘phys-
6 ical therapist’ means an individual who—
7 “(A) has received, at a minimum, a grad-
8 uate degree in physical therapy from an institu-
9 tion of higher education accredited by an agen-
10 cy or association recognized by the Secretary
11 pursuant to section 496(a) of this Act; and
12 “(B) provides physical therapy services
13 under 1861(p) of the Social Security Act (42
14 U.S.C. 1395x(p), or meets or exceeds the quali-

1 fications for a qualified physical therapist as de-
2 termined by State law.
