AMENDMENT TO H.R. 720
OFFERED BY MR. WHITFIELD OF KENTUCKY

At the end of title I, insert the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 104. POOL ELEVATION PILOT PROGRAM.**

2 (a) **PILOT PROGRAM.**—Notwithstanding any other
3 provision of Federal law, beginning in the first July after
4 the date of enactment of this Act, the Army Corps of En-
5 gineers, together with any other Federal agency that has
6 the authority to change the pool elevation of Lake Bar-
7 kley, Kentucky, shall establish and conduct a pilot pro-
8 gram that, under normal weather conditions, extends the
9 summer pool elevation of 359 feet on such lake from the
10 current draw down date of July 1 until after the first Mon-
11 day in September.

12 (b) **PILOT PROGRAM DURATION.**—Except as pro-
13 vided in subsection (d), the pilot program shall terminate
14 on the first Monday in September two years after the pilot
15 program begins.

16 (c) **EVALUATION AND RECOMMENDATIONS.**—Not
17 later than 60 days after the first Monday in September
18 two years after the pilot program begins, the Chief of En-
19 gineers of the Army Corps of Engineers shall evaluate the

1 effectiveness of extending the pool elevation on Lake Bar-
2 kley, Kentucky, under subsection (a) and report to the ap-
3 propriate committees of Congress their findings, including
4 any recommendations, regarding the extension of time for
5 such lake elevation.

6 (d) CONTINUATION.—If the Army Corps of Engi-
7 neers determines that the pilot program under this section
8 is effective, the Corps shall continue the summer elevation
9 of 359 feet on Lake Barkley, Kentucky, through the first
10 Monday in September each year.
