Mr. NUGENT, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution;
which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 47) To reauthorize
the Violence Against Women Act of 1994.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (S.
3 47) to reauthorize the Violence Against Women Act of
4 1994. All points of order against consideration of the bill
5 are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points
6 of order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
7 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
8 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without

1 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
2 divided and controlled by the Majority Leader and the Mi-
3 nority Leader or their respective designees; (2) an amend-
4 ment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text
5 of Rules Committee Print 113-2, if offered by the Majority
6 Leader or his designee, which shall be in order without
7 intervention of any point of order, shall be considered as
8 read, and shall be separately debatable for 20 minutes
9 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
10 opponent; and (3) one motion to commit with or without
11 instructions.
