OFFERED BY MR. HASTINGS OF FLORIDA

Page 3, line 18, strike “or (d)” and insert the following: “(d), or (e)”.

Page 5, insert after line 7 the following:

1 (e) SIGNIFICANT REGULATORY ACTIONS PRO-
2 TECTING SENIOR CITIZENS.—The moratorium in section
3 102(a) shall not apply to any significant regulatory action
4 that is intended to protect senior citizens’ rights and bene-
5 fits, including, but not limited to, access to health care,
6 Medicare, Social Security, disability assistance, food
7 stamps, nursing care, and other programs.

Page 10, insert after line 13 the following and redesignate provisions accordingly:

8 (c) EXCEPTION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS.—Section 202
9 shall not apply to a midnight rule that is intended to pro-
10 tect senior citizens’ rights and benefits, including, but not
11 limited to, access to health care, Medicare, Social Security,
12 disability assistance, food stamps, nursing care, and other
13 programs.

Page 20, insert after line 12 the following:

1 SEC. 305. EXCEPTION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS.

2 The provisions of this title do not apply to any con-
3 sent decree or settlement agreement pertaining to a regu-
4 latory action that is intended to protect senior citizens'
5 rights and benefits, including, but not limited to, access
6 to health care, Medicare, Social Security, disability assist-
7 ance, food stamps, nursing care, and other programs.
