

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5743, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. THOMPSON OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of title IV, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 405. NATIONAL RECONNAISSANCE OFFICE SCIENCE,**  
2 **TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATH CO-**  
3 **OPERATIVE PROGRAM.**

4 (a) PROGRAM.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subtitle A of title X of the  
6 National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 441g et  
7 seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following  
8 new section:

9 “EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY,  
10 ENGINEERING, AND MATH COOPERATIVE PROGRAM

11 “SEC. 1003. (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Director of  
12 the National Reconnaissance Office shall establish a pro-  
13 gram to provide grants to educational institutions to train  
14 undergraduate and graduate students who are eligible to  
15 receive an appropriate security clearance in areas of study  
16 relating to science, technology, engineering, or math of im-  
17 portance to the intelligence community.

18 “(b) FELLOWSHIP REQUIREMENT.—Each student  
19 participating in the program established under subsection

1 (a) shall complete a full-time fellowship of six months with  
2 an element of the intelligence community.”.

3 (2) TABLE OF CONTENTS AMENDMENT.—The  
4 table of contents in the first section of the National  
5 Security Act of 1947 is amended by inserting after  
6 the item relating to section 1002 the following new  
7 item:

“Sec. 1003. Educational Institution Science, Technology, Engineering, and  
Math cooperative program.”.

8 (b) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than October 1,  
9 2012, the Director of the National Reconnaissance Office  
10 shall establish the program required under section 1003  
11 of the National Security Act of 1947, as added by sub-  
12 section (a).

13 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
14 on which the Director of the National Reconnaissance Of-  
15 fice establishes the program required under section 1003  
16 of the National Security Act of 1947, as added by sub-  
17 section (a), the Director shall submit to the congressional  
18 intelligence committees a report on the status of the pro-  
19 gram established under such section 1003, including funds  
20 utilized, number of students in the program, number of  
21 students subsequently employed in the intelligence com-  
22 munity workforce and the coordinated university pro-  
23 grams.
