

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1540, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. TIERNEY OF MASSACHUSETTS**

At the end of subtitle I of title X, add the following
new section:

**1 SEC. 1099C. REPORT ON UNITED STATES STRATEGY RELAT-
2 ING TO AFGHANISTAN.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense,
5 in consultation with the Director of National Intelligence,
6 the Secretary of State, the Secretary of the Treasury (act-
7 ing through the head of the Office of Foreign Assets Con-
8 trol), the Attorney General, and any other officials the
9 Secretary of Defense considers appropriate, shall submit
10 to the appropriate congressional committees, the congres-
11 sional intelligence committees, and the Director of the Na-
12 tional Security Council a report on the effects of carrying
13 out a United States strategy to provide counterterrorism
14 assistance to Afghanistan and to rely on the international
15 donor community to provide development assistance and
16 other related assistance to Afghanistan.

17 (b) FORM OF SUBMISSION.—The report required
18 under subsection (a) shall be submitted in an unclassified
19 form, but may include a classified annex.

1 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

2 (1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
3 TEES.—The term “appropriate congressional com-
4 mittees” means the following:

5 (A) The Committee on Appropriations, the
6 Committee on Armed Services, the Committee
7 on the Budget, the Committee on Banking,
8 Housing, and Urban Affairs, the Committee on
9 Foreign Relations, the Committee on the Judi-
10 ciary, and the Committee on Homeland Secu-
11 rity and Governmental Affairs of the Senate.

12 (B) The Committee on Appropriations, the
13 Committee on Armed Services, the Committee
14 on the Budget, the Committee on Financial
15 Services, the Committee on Foreign Affairs, the
16 Committee on the Judiciary, and the Com-
17 mittee on Oversight and Government Reform of
18 the House of Representatives.

19 (2) CONGRESSIONAL INTELLIGENCE COMMIT-
20 TEES.—The term “congressional intelligence com-
21 mittees” means—

22 (A) the Select Committee on Intelligence of
23 the Senate; and

1 (B) the Permanent Select Committee on
2 Intelligence of the House of Representatives.
